not consume or possess alcohol of any kind, any proscribed drug or any paraphernalia.

submit to random drug testing.

report to CSO as directed, for bond supervision, and adhere to the conditions set forth on the order attached hereto.

pay the \$100.00 BIDS fee within 30 days of release on bond.

comply with all conditions of probation previously imposed.
